Opening Remarks, Brent Bagnall CORA president

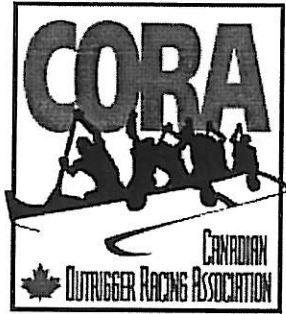
Financial Review - Peter Forand CORA Treasurer - Peter presented a short slide presentation on CORA's financial picture over the past year.
